



Medication in Schools Policy

Medication

No medication should be given to students without the prior **written** consent of the parent/guardian. Parents/guardians are requested to bring to the School Office a small amount of paracetamol if their child/ren require them, in an envelope with the student's name on and date.

If the child/ren are on daily medication that needs to be taken whilst in school time, only the required amount of tablets for that day are left with the Office Staff who place such medication in the locked Medication Box in the Medical Room. Antibiotic syrup will be kept in the office fridge on a daily basis and it is the responsibility of the student to come to the School Office to take/collect the medication daily. The Medication Box is located in the Medical Room in the School Office area for the use of qualified first aiders and is maintained by the appointed first aider.
